OUR PHILOSOPHY

Pediatricians and pediatric sub-specialists devote their entire training and careers to the study and care of children. They have extensive knowledge of childhood disease and sensitivity to a child's psychology. Because of this, they are uniquely qualified to deliver medical care to this age group. No other kind of medical provider can match the quality of care they will provide. The same is true of pediatric hospitals dedicated solely to children. It is therefore our policy to admit only to pediatric institutions and refer to only the best and most up to date pediatric sub-specialists. We follow the guidelines and recommendations provided by the American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP) and by providing evidence-based care.

Office hours are by appointment only. We have regular day, evening, & weekend hours. Our policy is to see every sick child the same day - when you call during office hours. For non-urgent questions or concerns, our providers can be reached through the MyChart portal.

Those arriving more than 10 minutes late for a non-urgent visit may be rescheduled.

INSURANCE/FINANCIAL POLICY

We contract with most insurances, and submit directly to nearly all carriers*. Parents are responsible for all office charges, and payment is expected at the time of service**. Unpaid balances are billed monthly. We accept all major credit cards, and online payments are available on our website.

Before your first visit with us, please have your past medical records sent to our office. Then call our front desk to schedule a new patient appointment.

EMERGENCIES & AFTER-HOURS

Genuine emergencies fall into the categories of problems with breathing, bleeding, or consciousness. In a true emergency always call 911 and be taken immediately to the nearest emergency room. After the situation has been stabilized by the emergency room, however, pediatricians and pediatric sub-specialists are the best qualified to provide definitive diagnosis and further treatment for your child.

For urgent care visits that do not require 911, call us first! One of our providers is always available -- 24 hours a day, 7 days a week -- to give advice or make arrangements for your child to be seen, either by us at the office or by an appropriate pediatric specialist at Boston Children's Hospital (BCH) or Mass General Hospital for Children (MGHfC). These institutions can be trusted to provide the highest level of pediatric medical and subspecialty care that we insist on for our patients. Existing patients should send records if seen at an outside organization.

After hours, when you call our main number, it will automatically direct you to speak with the provider on call.

We provide a comprehensive Acute Illness Guide to every family (and on our website) that gives guidelines for routine illness and injury.
